 - Email went out to families to donate side items for the Acapulco luncheon and volunteer to come in to help

o BUDGET:

- 2018-2019 Budget Updates
 - Anne will email staff for check request deadline
 - APEX- budgeted \$17,000, made \$25,786
 - Book Fair- budgeted \$2500, made \$1986
 - COMPAS- Amount up slightly from prior years, budget will be adjusted
 - 1st Grade Memory Books amount was higher than anticipated, budget will be adjusted
- Special Requests for tonight:
 - Approved: 3rd Grade Mr. Hovden requesting COMPAS creative writing author funding \$1,895- would cover one-week residency with all 3rd grade classes
 - We would like to make this a line item for future yearswill need to be approved next time
 - Approved: Joy Peterson's Son's Eagle Scout Project to create an outdoor learning space. Many items already donated. This request is for the cost of the mulch and other various supplies needed. \$350 requested. Anne suggested also calling Zywiec's to see if they would be willing to donate some mulch as well. So, the request was approved, up to \$350, but if we can get it lower than \$350, great.
- Fundraising for 2018-2019
 - CherryDale filing for bankruptcy- possible that someone will buy them out and participating schools will not see changes but this is unsure (we should have more information and discuss in May)

- We discussed the idea of looking into other options- in favor of going away from selling products if possible, or even going to Fall donations only and go big in Spring with APEX
 - Idea to eliminate Fall fundraiser and have an October Read-a-thon/opt out and write a check (\$30 total - dollar a day?)
 - Candy looking into what this looks like at other schools
 - Possible Chair needed to develop this day, invite in celebrities to read, etc.
 - Read-a-Thon could be presented at Fall Family Night- possible bookmark given out that is used to document reading minutes, possible incentivesnicer bookmark, Scholastic Free Book Coupon

Other items

- Request was made to see if there's a possibility for students to go to a Washington County Park to plant trees- could a grade level attend to have students experience being in a County park, helping the environment. Possibly around Earth Day? Spring and testing may hinder this.
- Debriefing about Apex- if students earned X amount, they helped build a well in another Country...many kids were excited and could this be an opportunity for more kids at a later date.
